- >> gift

- >> We need to be saved through Christ's grace then we can be restored to our original state which is being good. Read carefully Ephesians 2:10...

- 4.) We are not saved <u>BY</u> works; but we are saved <u>UNTO</u> good works
- >> EPHESIANS 2:8-10 -

vs8. For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

Vs9. **Not of works**, lest any man should boast.

Vs10. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus **Unto Good Works**, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

Rightly Dividing the word of truth. 2 Tim 2:15

- >> We are saved by Grace Through Faith
- >> We are not saved by works, but unto good works
- >> Faith without works is dead, vain and unfruitful being alone
- >> Grace is God's Part Faith is our part.
- >> Faith & obedience to God's biblical plan of salvation, which in New Testament and in our time is, Faith in Jesus, Repentance in His Name, Baptism calling upon the Name of Jesus (both water and Spirit), Holy Living in Jesus Name.
